## D.P.S. Road Test Instructions – ADULT COURSE

Please read the instructions carefully. Feel free to ask for any clarification you may need.

Visit <u>www.mrdsdrivingcenter.com</u> to schedule an appointment. Please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to your appointment time. Our physical address is 507 E. Kay Street.

A fee of \$60 will be charged to conduct the driving test. This allows you up to three chances to pass for no additional fee. Retesting must be done within 3 months of the original test. Payment must be made upon arrival. (This fee is subject to change without notice.)

Students must be able to successfully demonstrate the correct ability to parallel park. (We offer tutorials for an additional fee. This must be scheduled in advance.)

BRING THE FOLLOWING FOR YOUR TEST:

- □ Current student driving permit issued by Texas DPS (Cannot be expired)
- "IMPACT" video completion certificate (Cannot be expired) <u>https://impacttexasdrivers.dps.texas.gov/</u>
- □ 6-HR adult course certificate (for ages 18-24)
- Proof of insurance for the vehicle in which you will test

If you bring your own vehicle, it must meet these requirements:

- □ Must display a current proof of insurance for vehicle used for testing
- □ Vehicle must display a front and a rear license plate, properly attached to the vehicle
- □ All signals & lights, including the "high mount" brake light must work
- □ Horn must work, as well as windshield wipers (If weather requires)
- □ Inside door handles must work

If you want to use our vehicle for the road test, there will be an additional fee of \$15 for this service. Please notify us in advance.

If the student doesn't pass the test, they must wait at least 24 hours before retesting.

Once the student passes the driving test, take the sealed test results to any DPS office for processing within 90 days of testing. Please schedule an appointment with the DPS. To schedule, visit <u>www.dps.texas.gov</u> and schedule a "change, replace, or renew Texas DL/permit" appointment.
